Andrea called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Father Brian opened in prayer.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

OLMC NEWS

Amanda Cook said that they met the scholarship challenge so OLMC has \$30,000 for tuition assistance. They are having more altar servers. The kids finished on May 21, 2021.

FATHER BRIAN REPORT

Father Brian discussed Saturday folk wanting to stay in cars. Discussion about the families

being in church. Father talked about problems with people being in the car - people on phones, people eating. Scott suggested establishing a Eucharistic station outside. It was decided to go with the same Memorial Day weekend - Eucharistic station the following weekend and inside church the third weekend.

Expanded capacity with Angela next. There were about 170 people in church on 5/23.

Tom Burton said that everything at St. Paul was good with check in and allowing more people in.

Cintia inquired. Mass hybrid will include check in - seating people, and more Eucharistic ministers. Father said that we won't need as many Eucharistic ministers when we move back in. 2-3 in church, 2-3 outside.

Father reported that we could have 2 altar servers now.

The remodeling of the FLC is going really well. Window treatments and baseboards are still needed. They are also working on the church roof. They will have a permanent solution to the leaking in the chapel.

We aren't getting our seminarian. The seminarian had not been vaccinated and Father Brian rightfully felt that he could not risk getting the virus from a non-vaccinated person even with Father Brian being vaccinated.


